


### Sun & Swell

# Pluck Tea

Jennifer Commins founded Pluck Tea with a mission to fix restaurant tea. Today, her team of tea makers in Ontario, Canada, hand-blends a wide range of small-batch infusions for tea drinkers who value quality and sustainability.

Several ingredients are grown and dried on farms close to their facility while others are sourced from producers throughout Canada that otherwise would discard or compost them—like citrus peels, roasted cacao shells, dried apple pieces, and grape skins.

Pluck Teas are packaged into glass stackable jars and delivered to Toronto customers by Drop Distribution, an emission-free delivery service.
